DECLARATION
on Directive 2011/65 / EU of the European Parliament and of the Council and on Commission Directive 2015/863 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65 / EU, as regards the list of restricted substances limiting the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

Product family: Cold Rolled, Hot Dip Galvanized, Packaging steels, Electrical steels including varnishes, oiled or unoled, and their packaging. Includes coils, blanks, tailored welded blanks, shaped blanks.

Steel products listed here, including protective oils and the material used for their packaging, are in accordance with European Directive on electric and electronic equipments.

The maximum content of hazardous substances is:

Lead (Pb)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Mercury (Hg)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Cadmium (Cd)	0.01% by weight (100 ppm)
Hexavalent Chromium	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1% by weight (1000 ppm)

Products containing the substances listed above in concentrations below the MCV are understood to be in compliance with directive 2011/65 / EU of the European Parliament and the Council and with Commission Directive 2015/863 on the restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronics equipment (RoHS Directive).
